Isabella County Medical Care Facility (ICMCF) COVID-19 Response

To our residents, families and visitors;

As of today, 13 Isabella County Medical Care Facility residents have recovered from COVID and five are still recovering from the virus in our isolated unit. Our recovered residents are 30 days post diagnosis, not hospitalized and returned to baseline health status with no symptoms. All ICMCF COVID-positive residents remain in our care, and we have had no additional losses to the virus. Currently we do not have any staff members ill with positive COVID test results or related symptoms.

On May 4, 2020 ICMCF began testing the remaining 45 asymptomatic residents who had not been previously tested. The results revealed there were NO additional residents testing positive.

The steps we're taking are working. This is a testament to our Amazing staff here at ICMCF. We appreciate their dedication to muster strength to come to work every day during a very challenging time. They bring positive attitudes matched with determination and diligence to adhere to our stringent infection control and personal protective equipment procedures ensuring their safety as well as the residents.

We celebrate the recovery of our residents including one who is 102 years young. Our effected residents overcame many obstacles to reach their recovery, including multiple co-morbidities, advanced age and frailty. With their own tenacity and the compassionate skilled care from our staff, together we have fought this virus with success stories.

Thank you to our community for the multiple donations we have received which have encouraged and assisted us in our fight. The staff at ICMCF are forever grateful to the central Michigan community for all the heartfelt support.
