Isabella County Medical Care Facility (ICMCF) COVID-19 Response

To our staff, residents, families and visitors;

We can't wait, tomorrow our doors open to more visitors! Unvaccinated residents and unvaccinated visitors can continue to schedule indoor visits in our Adult Day Program area by calling Deb Nartker at (989) 779-5558. Indoor visitation is also restricted for residents who require Transmission-Based Precautions, i.e. occupants of our transition unit.

Visitors who can provide proof of their full vaccination status can have in room visits with our vaccinated residents under the following guidelines:

- Screening in for visitation will be during normal business hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. At this time visitors will be restricted from entering the building after 4:30 p.m. but once screened in can remain in the resident's room until their visit is over.
- Visitors do not need an appointment.
- We will encourage visitors to complete COVID 19 testing.
- Visitors will be screened and will not be allowed to visit if they have a current COVID infection, symptoms of COVID or close contact with someone with a COVID 19 infection in the prior 14 days or meet criteria for their own quarantine.
- Visitors will be required to wear appropriate facemasks, facemasks are required to be worn correctly, over mouth and nose, for the entire duration of the visit.
- Maintain 6ft social distancing with facility staff and other residents.
- Ensure they perform hand hygiene when entering and exiting the facility.
- Visits are limited to two guests at a time in the resident's room. Please check out to allow the resident to have additional visitors.
- Visits will be permitted in resident rooms only, visitors are not allowed to visit other residents, or to linger in common areas, i.e. dining and activity rooms.
- Food may be brought in for the resident, but food is not allowed to be consumed by the visitor during the visit.
- If at any time a guest is not able to follow the Indoor Visit Guidelines, that individual will be asked to leave immediately.

Staff and residents are very excited to see you soon. We will continue to keep everyone up to date on changes in visitation. Thank you for your continued support.
